

Breaking News: Tax Day is now May 17th; the IRS and most states have extended the filing deadline allowing for an extra month to get your taxes prepared. This extension is only for the filing of 1040 returns and any payments due for 2020 tax year. However, the 1st estimate payment for 2021 are due on April 15th for both Federal and MI. If you normally pay estimates to either the IRS or MI, you still need to have your income taxes prepared on or before April 15th to avoid any late payment penalties.

Unemployment News: If you filed your return before March 12th and had unemployment, the IRS is telling us you will not need to amend your return to get the extra deduction on your taxes. At this time, the IRS has stated they will automatically adjust the tax return and will issue any refunds as a separate deposit at a later date.
